Adopt a Cat while at CATS

C.A.R.E.



On Sunday, September 19, SLT and C.A.R.E. Animal Rescue are partnering for a cat adoption at the Landers from 12 pm to 4 pm.

C.A.R.E. was the first no-kill shelter in the area, and we remain a no-kill facility. They focus heavily on rescue, rehab, and adoption. All of their animals are rescued from "Death Row" at Animal Control. On average, they adopt out around 1,000 animals to happy, forever homes per year. ALL of the animals are spayed/neutered, vaccinated, dewormed, prior to adoption and sent home with a collar and tag. Their mission is to...

- Rescue as many adoptable animals from "death row" as we can properly care for.
- Provide medical treatment to sick or injured stray animals
- Combine an aggressive spay/neuter program with a high volume adoption program while providing quality lifetime care for unadopted pets.
- Network with and provide a rescue service for other shelters, ultimately reducing the kill-rate in Southwest Missouri.

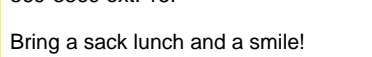
The school year is just beginning, but that also means the start of School's Out Workshops! **The first School's Out Workshop is Monday, September 6.**

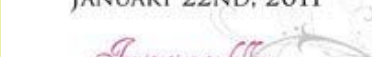

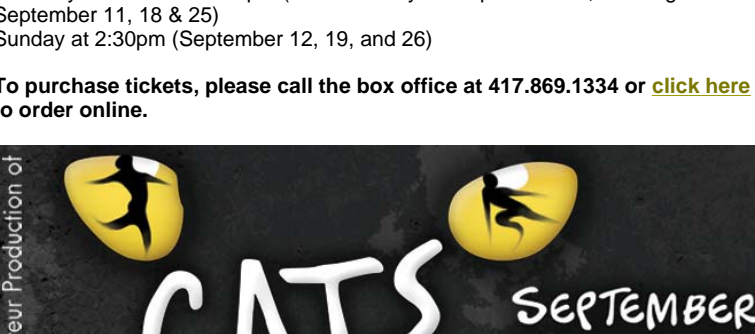
CATS Opens September 10!

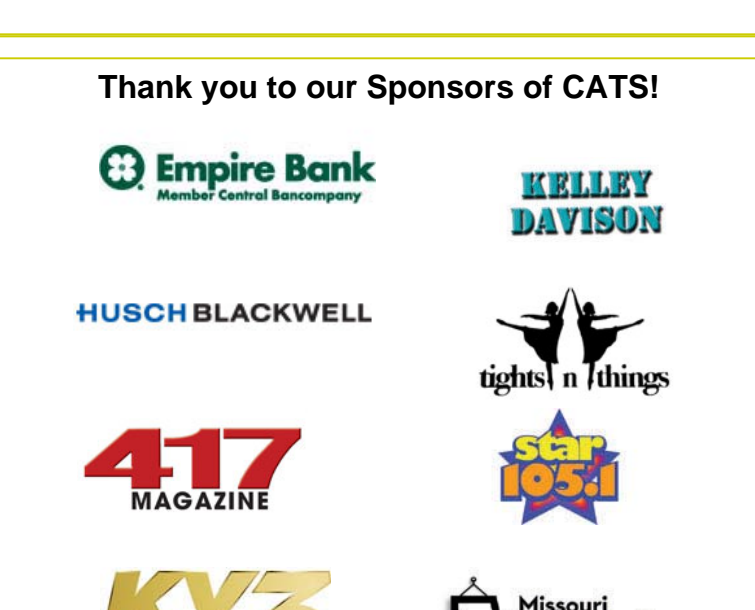
