ABOUT GREASE

Grease is among the world's most popular musicals and the *Grease School Edition* serves up an abridged version that is shorter and more suitable in content for young performers while retaining the fun-loving spirit and immortal songs that make *GREASE* a favorite among rock and roll fans of all ages!

It's 1959, and Rydell High School's senior class is in rare form. The 1950s high school dream is about to explode in a rollicking musical that is both an homage to the idealism of the 50s and a satire of high schoolers' age-old desire to be rebellious. At the heart of the story is the romance between hot-rodding gangster Danny Zuko and the sweet new girl in town, Sandy Dumbrowski. They had a secret romance during the summer, but now back in the context of school, peer-pressure and cliques make their love a bit more complicated. Can Danny maintain his cool dude status and still make demure Sandy his girl? The whole gang sings and dances around Danny and Sandy's romance, through such hit songs as "Greased Lightnin'", "We Go Together", and "Born To Hand Jive", recalling the music of Buddy Holly, Little Richard and Elvis Presley that became the soundtrack of a generation.
